


Aging Land Owners

Regulations Prevent Adaptation

Consequences of Zoning

- Farms & forests historically had businesses
- Prohibits most businesses in residential areas
- Assumes all business will be primary uses
- Prevents innovation and new business





Home-based Occupations





Any activity carried out for gain by a resident as an accessory use in the resident's home

Accessory Use

Use of land or building customarily incidental and subordinate to the principal use

... shall not be permitted without the principal use to which it is related.

Common Residential Accessory Uses

- Barns
- Garages
- Home occupations
- Outbuildings
- Swimming pools

Rural Comprehensive Plan Policies

- Allow rural way of life to be enjoyed by future generations.
- Protect and promote agricultural uses.....
- Use all available means to conserve the town's remaining forestland....
- Protect sufficient forestland to meet present and future needs.

Rural Zoning Policies

Purpose: "To provide for the preservation and promotion of agricultural production, forestry, timber and open space...."

Farm/Forest Uses Allowed by Right

Raise farm crops and forest products

 Buildings to support agriculture such as barns, greenhouses, silos, etc.

Uses not listed are prohibited

- Sale of compost/mulch
- Artistic products/crafts
- Farm café/restaurant








Do you think this use is appropriate in rural areas?


